How to find us

The main College campus is located on the Ipswich Road approximately 1/2 mile from the City Centre.

From the St Stephen's Street roundabout (near the bus station), follow the signs to Ipswich.

A few hundred metres south of the roundabout the A11 and 140 divide; take the left fork and the College is about 300 metres further along on the left (see first map on reverse).

By Train



The main Norwich Thorpe train station is located about 1.5 miles from the College. There are three buses that run from the train station near to City College. Green line number 14 & 15 which runs every 15 minutes dropping off at New Market Road – 2 minutes from College. Red line 23 & 24 which runs every 7 minutes drop off at Theatre street – 12 minutes from College. Blue line 25 & 26 which runs every 7 minutes dropping off at Red Lion Street – 10 minutes from College.

By Park and Ride



The Park & Ride routes covering City College's Ipswich Road campus are:

- Harford Park & Ride
- Sprowston Park & Ride

Airport and Thickthorn P&R sites operate to Newmarket Road/Town Close Road which is a 5 minute walk. Postwick P&R operates to St Stephens Street in the city centre which is a 8 minute walk.

Routes run Monday to Saturday with arrivals in the city before 7am and last buses back at approximately 7pm depending on the site. A 16-19 (no ID required!) day ticket is £1.90 and a 10 day ticket is £14.70. More fares and times information is available at www.norwichparkandride.co.uk

By Bus

By Car



There are limited car parking facilities at the College (which do fill up very quickly on a morning). We recommend, where possible, that you use alternative forms of transport.

Car Parking is on a first come, first served basis for visitors, with an hourly charge of 50p. Visitor parking is generally located at the front of the main Norwich Building.

Students

Parking is available to students on a pay and display basis (current daily fee is £3; £1.50 per half day after 1pm).

The student car park is located at the top of Waveney Drive via the Southwell Entrance to the College.

Parking for staff is by paid permit (these are available from Human Resources) or by pay and display. Payment machines are located in all car parks. The main staff car park is located at the north end of the campus via the main staff/visitor entrance.

There is a dedicated space for charging up electric vehicles free of charge in front of the main Norwich building.

By Motorcycle



A parking area for motorcycles is located to the front of the main student car park. Motorcycles are exempt from pay and display charges.

Car share



If you are interested in car sharing, there is a scheme run in Norfolk which the College supports (along with City and County Council). Log onto www.carsharenorfolk.com for full details or call 08700 11 11 99.

By Bicycle

The College has a number of cycle racks, changing rooms and shower facilities available for use.

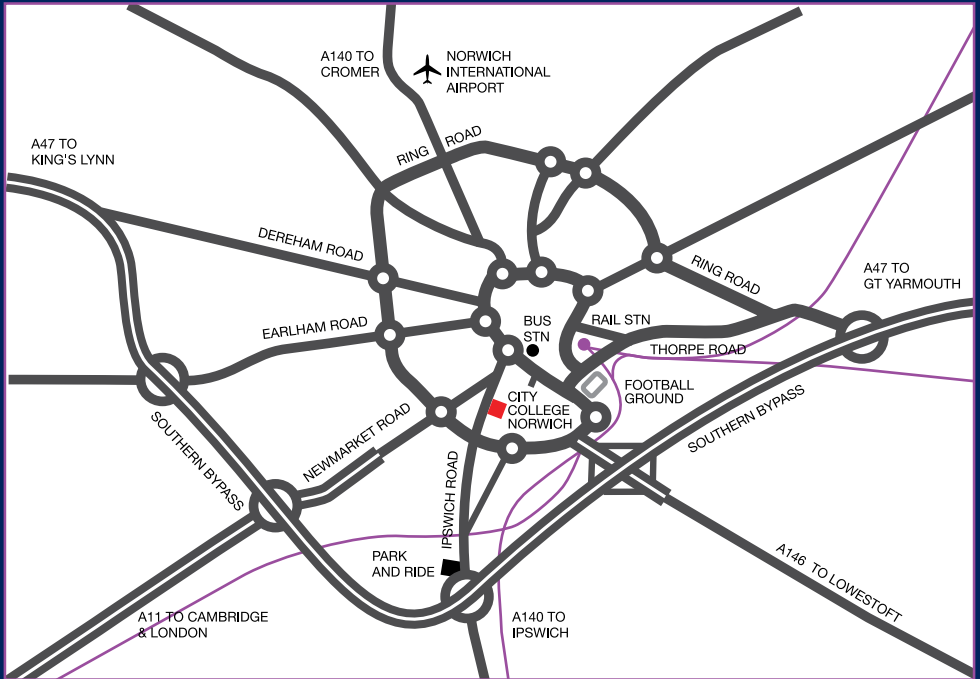
On Foot



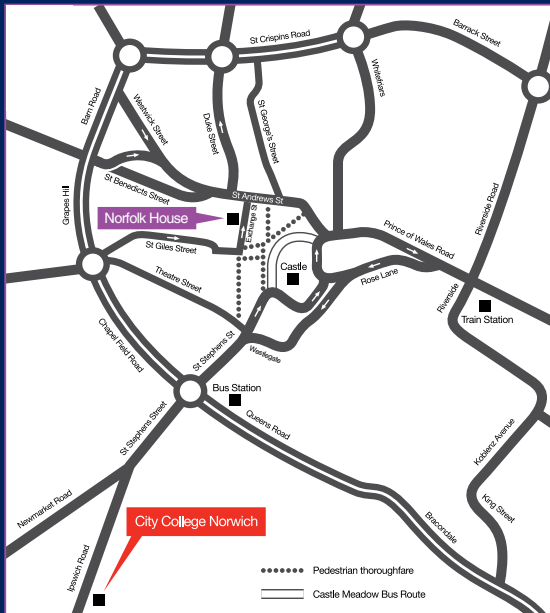
There is a good network of well lit pathways to and from the College, and safe crossing points across Ipswich Road.
